



Content Dispute

If you believe that content available on a website that is controlled or operated by GE (e.g., www.gesoftware.com, www.Predix.io) violates your intellectual property rights, you may use this form to submit an infringement notice. As part of our response, we may remove or disable access to material that is claimed to be infringing. We will also make a good-faith attempt to contact the person or account holder who submitted the affected content so that they may have an opportunity to provide a counter notice.

GE abides by the federal Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA) by responding to notices of alleged infringement that comply with the DMCA and other analogous laws in other jurisdictions. We will only consider DMCA takedown requests that fully comply with the requirements of the DMCA and incomplete requests will not be responded to or considered.

Disputes with Third Party Content

While GE may provide information about or access to third party content, including catalog apps, analytics, microservices and/or websites, GE does not control such content.

By submitting information concerning third party content, you consent to GE sharing your name, company affiliation and email address and the information concerning your claim with the third party so that we email both of you to work directly together to resolve any dispute.
